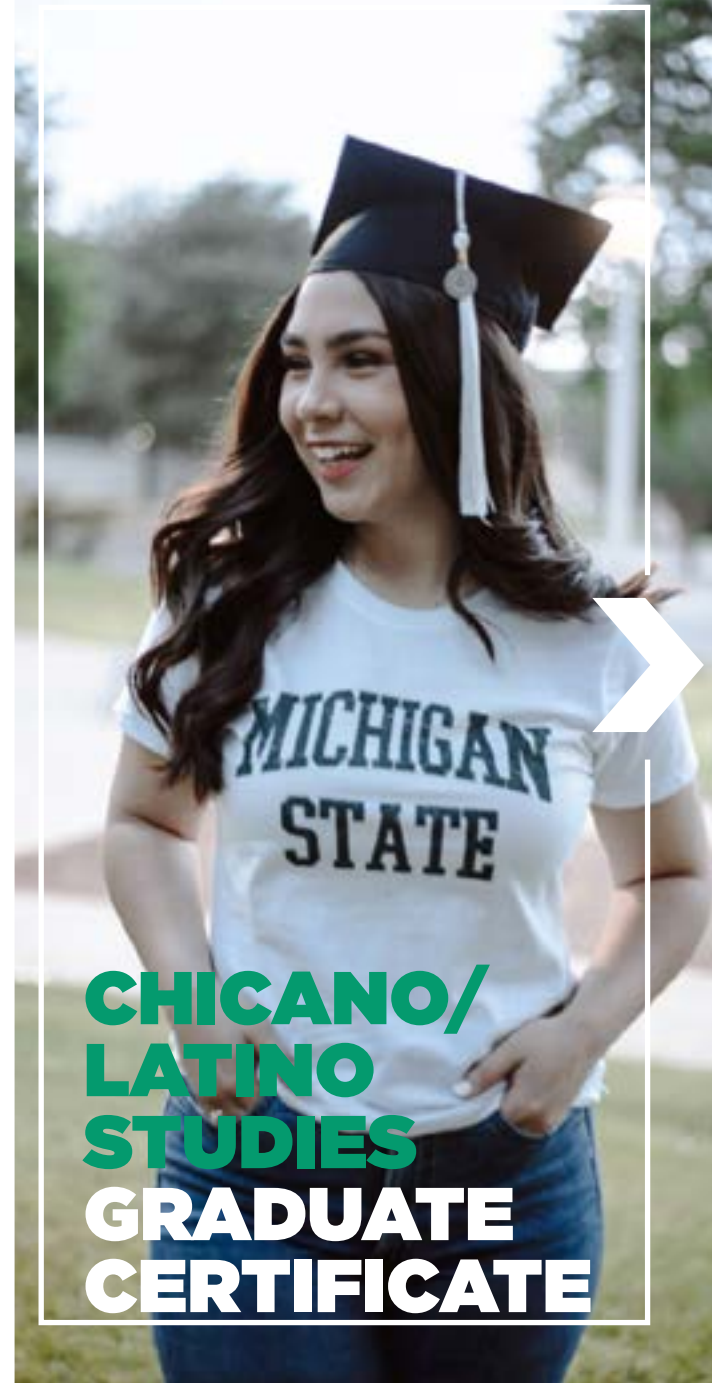

## ABOUT THE CHICANO/LATINO STUDIES GRADUATE CERTIFICATE

The Graduate Certificate in Chicano/Latino Studies exposes students to methodologies specific to Chicano/Latino Studies, and to debates in the field that reflect larger transformations in United States culture and society. Students interested in research related to Chicanxs and Latinxs in the United States will find this certificate program of interest.

## ADMISSION

To be considered for admission to the Graduate Certificate in Chicano/Latino Studies, students must:

- Have a bachelor's degree.
- Be currently enrolled in a Michigan State University graduate degree program other than the Doctor of Philosophy degree program in Chicano/Latino Studies.
- Have a minimum grade-point average of 3.0.

## REQUIREMENTS

Submit the CLS Graduate Certificate application.

To be awarded the Graduate Certificate in Chicano/Latino Studies, students must complete the following requirements:

### REQUIRED COURSES:

- **CLS 810** Historiography and Social Science: Methods in Chicano/Latino Studies
- **CLS 811** Literary and Cultural Theory in Chicano/Latino Studies
- **CLS 896** Seminar in Chicano/Latino Studies
- Complete three credits in related content from another department or graduate-level program as approved by the Chicano/Latino Studies director

### COMPLETION OF CERTIFICATE

When all requirements are met, students must fill out and submit a "Certification of Completion of the Graduate Certificate in CLS" form to our office. The form is available on our website at [clstudies.msu.edu](http://clstudies.msu.edu).
